CONSTRUCTION NEWS UPDATES

U.S. Senator Dick Durbin (D-IL) and U.S. Representative Tammy Duckworth (D-IL) announced last week that the Department of Transportation had signed off on a final agreement that will allow the State of Illinois - after decades of preparation - to finally begin construction on the Elgin-O'Hare Western Access roadway.

The project, combined with the surrounding development and other infrastructure projects, stands to create as many as 65,000 direct and indirect jobs by 2040.

The \$3.4 billion Western Access project will extend the Elgin-O'Hare Expressway to O'Hare and build a new Western Bypass around the airport. An official agreement to formalize the transfer of a federal roadway to a tolling authority has been awaiting approval by the Federal Highway Administration.

CYPRESS CREEK CALL TO ACTION

HB 3636 has passed the Illinois House and Senate. This bill to restore the Mechanics Lien Act in Illinois to its status prior to the disastrous decision by the IL Supreme Court is awaiting the signature of Gov. Pat Quinn. Please send your letter on company letterhead ASAP urging Gov. Quinn to sign HB 3636 on behalf of the union construction industry. The bank lobby is trying hard to convince the Governor not to sign the bill - so letters from contractors and building trades representatives like you are critical.
