UPCOMING FREE CISCO WORKSHOPS

CISCO will be offering two FREE workshops in June. The first workshop involves a partnership with the Illinois Tollway in order to provide contractors and building trades organizations the chance to learn more about the job bidding opportunities, prequalification and contract requirements, and diversity hiring that are part of the Tollway's \$12 billion, 15-year Capital Plan.

This event will be held from 9:00 a.m. - noon, **Wednesday, June 12** at IBEW 701, 28600 Bella Vista Parkway in Warrenville, IL. The Illinois Tollway and NECA-IBEW 701 LMCC are cosponsoring this opportunity.

The second workshop presentation will be held on **Monday, June 24**, and will also be hosted by NECA-IBEW 701 LMCC in Warrenville. The event is one of CISCO's traditional Public Construction Workshops that focuses on issues involved with the Prevailing Wage and Misclassification Acts, the Freedom of Information Act, and the value of Responsible Bidder Ordinances. The event will run from 9:00 a.m. until noon.

CISCO will once again join forces with the Department of Labor, the Attorney General's Office and the Indiana, Illinois and Iowa Foundation for Fair Contracting (III-FFC) to pass along valuable information regarding compliance, case examples and penalties and other consequences.
