GOVERNOR PRITZKER SIGNS "RETAINAGE" BILL INTO LAW

Late last month, Illinois Governor J.B. Pritzker signed SB 1636 into law.

This bill lowers retainage from 10% to 5% once, 50 percent of a construction project is complete. One of the goals of this legislation was to ease contractors' cash flow burdens and encourage new developments in the state.
