> Michael Kleinik - Governor JB Pritzker recently appointed Mr. Kleinik to serve as the new Director of the Illinois Department of Labor (IDOL).

Mr. Kleinik's career has focused on enforcing the law. Beginning as a Vandalia police officer and followed by two terms as Fayette County Sheriff, he moved onto serving as field supervisor for the Midwest Region Foundation for Fair Contracting - an organization dedicated to ensuring the enforcement of laws governing the construction industry.

Michael also has experience at the IDOL, having previously held the positions of chief of staff and manager of the Department's Conciliation and Mediation Division. He transitioned from the IDOL to the Chicago Laborers' District Council Labor-Management Cooperation Committee (LMCC), where he served as the LMCC Executive Director until his retirement in 2018.

Now Mr. Kleinik will protect Illinois workers and employers who play by the rules.
