Having led the City's response to the pandemic, which included unprecedented health and economic issues, she has passed ordinances that impact working families by 1) increasing minimum wage in the City, and 2) allowing

work schedules to be known 10 days in advance, (Fair Work Week Ordinance) thus helping working families plan for family needs.

Lightfoot's economic plan to reinvest in the City's south and west side sides will be complemented with major, transformative construction projects such as The 78, Lincoln Yards, One Chicago, O'Hare 21, One Central and the Obama Presidential Center.

New construction jobs, vigorous recruitment of a diverse workforce, and revitalizing communities and neighborhoods are the goals that the union construction industry and Mayor Lightfoot share.
