Savings

The Plumbers Retirement Savings Fund 401(k) and/or Regular Savings Plan Deduction of a MINIMUM of \$1.50 per hour for each hour worked for each Journeyman and \$1.00 per hour MINIMUM for each hour worked for 4th and 5th year Apprentices remains unchanged. First, Second and Third year apprentices are exempt from this deduction. A Participant CAN DIRECT MORE than the base contribution rate of \$1.50 per hour, in increments of fifty (\$0.50) cents per hour, but NOT MORE THAN \$10.00 PER HOUR to the 401(k) Plan, NOT TO EXCEED THE ANNUAL IRS LIMITS.

Working Dues

The employer shall deduct (after taxes) sixty five cents (\$0.65) per hour for each hour worked for each Journeyman, Foreman, Superintendent, General Superintendent and Metal Trades Journeyman and fifty four cents (\$0.54) per hour for each hour worked for Apprentices, with the exception of 1st Year – 1st Six Months Apprentices and 1st Year 1st Three Month Metal Trades Journeymen for Working Dues.

Funds Changes

The contribution to the Welfare Fund has been increased by ninety four cents (\$0.94) from \$11.59 to \$12.53.

The contribution to the Pension Fund has been increased by one dollar (\$1.00) from \$9.06 to \$0.06.

There is a five cent (\$0.05) increase to the Promotion Fund that has been reinstated by the Plumbing Contractors Association of Chicago and Cook County as per the 2010 Collective Bargaining Agreement.

The contribution to the Education and Legal Funds for June 1, 2012 will remain the same.

*This, in effect, results in a total increase effective June 1, 2012 of two dollars and twenty five cents (\$2.25) per hour. *
